Tomorrow, Tuesday 14th May will be the start of the 2019 Naplan Testing period. Students in Years 3 and 5 will sit online tests in Writing, Reading Comprehension, Language Conventions and Numeracy. Every student has the opportunity to trial the types of test questions, and understand the interactive test format and specific NAPLAN online tools by visiting ACARA's public demonstration site. Students are encouraged to complete appropriate tests for their year level.
