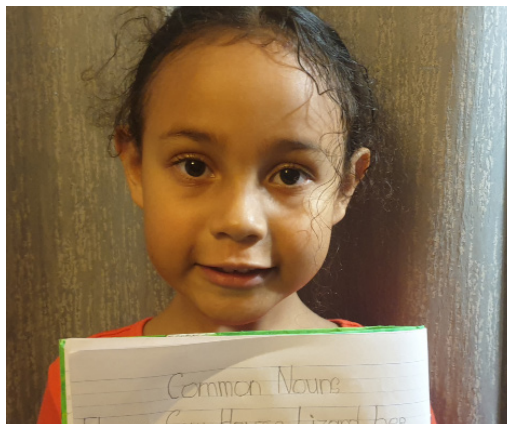

Mack- Responsible- Accepting staff feedback on writing draft

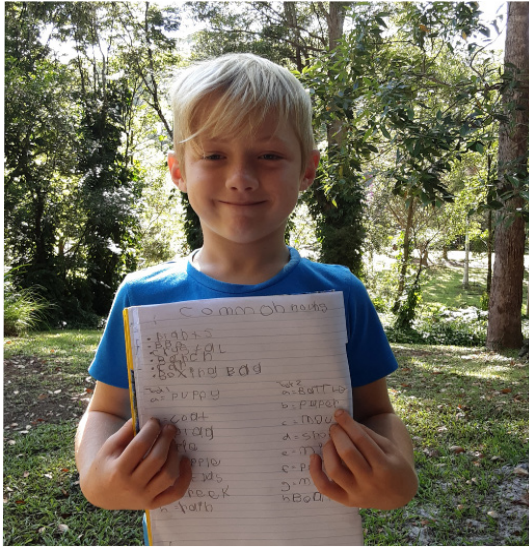
Sari- Responsible- Contacting staff for assistance

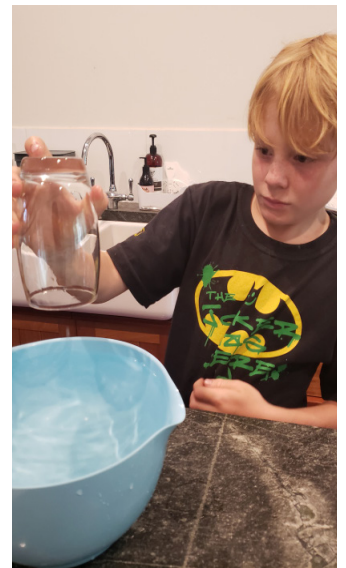

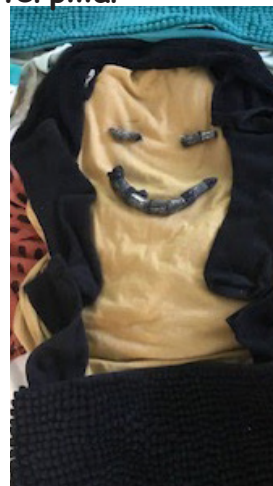
Maya's Turtle - Laundry Art
