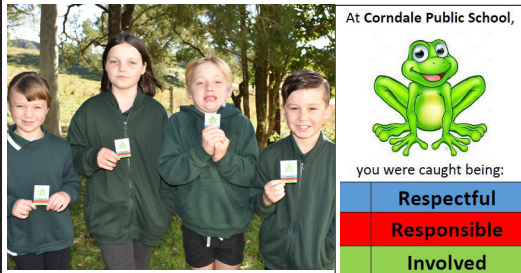
FUN FRIDAY
